



Job Title: Dump Truck Driver
Department: Project Jobsite

FLSA status: Hourly Craft Worker
Reports to: Superintendent



Position Summary:

The Truck Driver is responsible for operating the dump truck in a safe and appropriate manner. The Truck Driver will haul recently excavated soil/dirt to storage location near jobsite. May operate additional equipment as needed. The Truck Driver may work in other crafts at levels appropriate to training and skills as requested by project supervision.

Example of Activities:

- ◆ The Truck Driver must also clean, maintain and secure all equipment as directed by policies and procedures
- ◆ Operate dump truck in a safe and effective manner in order to minimize the risk of injury, or property damage
- ◆ Perform safety and maintenance checks
- ◆ Clean equipment as scheduled and/or required
- ◆ Ensure equipment is safely and securely stored
- ◆ Advise supervisor of any requirements for maintenance or repairs
- ◆ Practice workplace safety
- ◆ Recording and maintaining all required paperwork
- ◆ Daily monitoring and reporting of mechanical issues with equipment
- ◆ Climbing of steel framework, stairs, ladders and scaffolds
- ◆ Proper response to all safety hazards and warning devices (i.e. back-up alarms, smell of smoke, different color warning tags, warning sirens, etc)

Essential knowledge, skills and responsibilities:

- ◆ Prefer minimum of High School Diploma or GED
- ◆ 2-5 years relevant work experience
- ◆ Knowledge of current laws and limits of trucking industry
- ◆ Valid Colorado CDL license with air brake endorsement
- ◆ Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen
- ◆ Must pass DOT physical examination, background check and MVR evaluation
- ◆ Ability to maintain satisfactory attendance and punctuality standard
- ◆ Excellent oral and written communication skills
- ◆ Ability to work independently

Valued but not required knowledge, skills and experience:

- ◆ All Class A CDL endorsements
- ◆ Bi-lingual Spanish (written and spoken)

Physical demands and work environment: Ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds. Requires willingness, at times, to work in a field (job-site) environment. Expose to rain, sleet, snow, dust, mud, heat, sun, cold, noise, and other conditions common to a construction site. Contractual obligations may require irregular hours, weekend, and holidays.
